## **Waiver of Liability**

In consideration of being allowed to participate in activities at Barbara's House (the "Summer Program"), I, the undersigned parent or legal guardian of the minor camper named above, do hereby waive, release, and covenant not to sue Barbara's House, its owners, employees, agents, and volunteers (collectively, the "Releasees") from any and all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action of any nature whatsoever arising out of or related to the Activity, including, but not limited to, any personal injury, property damage, or death sustained by the minor camper.

1. Assumption of Risk. Participant acknowledges and understands that participation in the Program involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury, illness, and property damage. Participant assumes full responsibility for any and all risks associated with participation in the Program.

2. Medical History Disclosure. Participant acknowledges that they have disclosed all relevant medical history information for Participant to Program, including any allergies, medications, and existing medical conditions.

3. Emergency Medical Care. Participant acknowledges that Program does not have a licensed nurse on staff and in the event of an emergency, Participant understands that Program staff cannot administer medications, however will take all reasonable steps to contact emergency medical services. Participant agrees to be financially responsible for any and all costs associated with emergency medical care provided to Participant during the Program.

4. Authorization for Medical Treatment. Participant hereby authorizes Program staff to seek emergency medical treatment for Participant in the event of an emergency. Participant also authorizes the release of any medical information necessary to obtain such treatment.

5. Hold Harmless. Participant, on behalf of themselves and their heirs, assigns, and successors, hereby agrees to hold harmless, indemnify, and defend Program, its officers, directors, employees, and volunteers from and against any and all claims, demands, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including attorney's fees) arising out of or in any way connected with Participant's participation in the Program.

6. Governing Law. This Waiver shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Connecticut.
